CERTIFIED GROUNDS MANAGER (CGM®)

Advance your career and receive national recognition as a CGM! This two-part certification process includes an application test and a Professional Grounds Manager Evaluation portfolio, which upon completion, serves as a working document to improve your skills as a grounds manager.

CERTIFIED GROUNDS TECHNICIAN (CGT®)

The CGT examination consists of questions covering multiple facets of grounds maintenance, including questions based on your region. A miniumum score of 70% is required to pass and continuing education units are required to maintain certification.

SCHOOL OF GROUNDS MANAGEMENT

Develop your skills as a grounds manager by completing this PGMS certificate program, which covers four core management competencies: Human Resources, Business and Finance, Technical Horticulture, and Technical Non-Horticulture.
